BASIC RULES

Player/Parent Contract

Limitless Basketball Florida, Inc.

Attendance:

Every effort should be made to attend all practices and be on time. That means, “on the court, warming up” by the start of each practice. If you are on time, you are late! However, we realize things come up so if you are running late, please call the coaching staff. Parent shall be solely responsible for ensuring that the player is transported to and from all practices, games, tournaments and related activities. Such transportation shall be at the parent's sole expense. The Limitless Basketball organization, coaching staff and board of directors assume no responsibility or liability for or in connection with the player's transportation to practices, games, tournaments, and/or activities.

Absences:

If a player must miss a practice, he or she must call the coach. When season starts, if a player misses a practice, he or she should not “expect” to start the following game, though, he or she may. This is not meant to punish players who must miss a practice, it is meant to encourage & reward players who are there. Player must also call the coach following missed practice to get an update and an upcoming schedule. The more a player is absent from practices, the less the chance that he or she will be playing in games or remaining on the team. In the event that a player misses practice or game or has to leave early from either, it is the responsibility of the player to call & get any updated information for upcoming events.

Injuries/Insurance:

In the event of an injury, if possible, the player should still attend practice. Much can be learned from helping coaches & listening to practice. If you are injured or become ill during a game or practice, it is your responsibility to your team to report it to a coach immediately.

Parents shall maintain medical, health, dental and accident insurance for the benefit of the player. Parents understand that insurance that is procured by Limitless Basketball Florida, Inc. will be secondary. Such insurance (if procured) will only provide benefits to the player once the limits of coverage of the insurance procured by the parent have been exhausted.

Player/parent agree to immediately notify the Limitless Basketball Florida, Inc. organization of any claim that the player was injured while participating in the Limitless Basketball traveling basketball team.

Attire/Equipment:

Parents shall be solely responsible for ensuring the player has the equipment necessary to play for the team including team shoes, team backpack, and other protective gear. Come prepared to play, Please do not wear attire from other organizations; we want players to represent our Limitless Basketball Organization.

Friends/Parents:

Practices are open to Parents. Friends or Parents should not attend practice “if” it is a distraction to “any” player. Players should always remember that practice/game time is not designated as time to visit with friends or family outside the field of play. If necessary, coaches may hold closed practices. Parents please refrain from coaching son or daughter from the bleachers!

Please be courteous to the Coaching staff & allow coaches to coach. Parents are encouraged to work with their son or daughter, but not during game time or practices. That includes comments or instruction when on the court & especially after a bad play, turn over missed shot. Outbursts & Disruptive Behavior from the Parents, Fans & Players will not be tolerated in this organization such actions will result in removal from team & organization. During game time, parents: don't be your child's Mom & Dad, Be their biggest fan!

Bench:

Coaches & players on bench “ONLY”. Parents are encouraged to support their children. However, during practices & games they should refrain from approaching the bench or court to coach, consult, or to critique their child. Players should not leave bench or court during games unless it is to use the restroom. Players should have everything they need with them while on the bench (contacts, medications, water, Gatorade, snacks etc.). Players are not to make phone calls or text message at any time during practice, tournament play or team meetings. Unless it is an emergency & permission is granted from the Coach.

Conduct:

Good sportsmanship & professional behavior is expected at all times in all circumstances by both the player and the parent. There should be no conversation with referees, coaches, players, or parents regarding a call or a play. We will not tolerate players that show disruptive behavior on the court or on the bench. Parent and player acknowledge and agree that when participating in activities organized by Limitless Basketball, coaching staff and/or it's board of directors their actions reflect on the reputation of Limitless Basketball's organization, coaching staff and it's players. Limitless Basketball reserves the right to dismiss any player who breaches good sportsmanship or ethics code of conduct from the Travel Team.

Uniforms:

Players should arrive in the correct uniform for all games & it should be clean & in good shape. Before warm ups start all Jerseys are to be tucked in & remain tucked in for the entire game! All Jewelry is to be off before the game starts.

Travel:

During the season there may be extensive travel. Please be advised that these travel days are not vacations! A lot of money has been spent to enable us to go to these events. As a team, we are going to tournaments with a purpose & that is to play basketball! It is the responsibility of the player & parent to adhere to all curfews any exceptions to this must be approved in advance by the coaching staff.

Addressing Concerns/Problems:

We encourage an open relationship between coaches, players & parents & keeping the communication line open. Parents should call the manager or coach to set up an appropriate time to address questions or concerns. For your sake & for the sake of the players DO NOT bring up concerns during & after a game or in the middle of a practice. It is easy to exhibit good sportsmanship when things are going our way. How do we conduct ourselves when things are not going our way? Please allow 24 hrs to pass after last game played on said given weekend before contacting coaches or staff.

FEE BREAKDOWN

2022-2023 FEE PAYMENT BREAKDOWN

.37 per hour x 24 hour = \$8.93

\$8.93 per day x 7 day's = \$62.50

\$62.50 a week x 4 weeks = \$250

\$250 a month x 10 months = \$2500

Registration Fee = \$400 (includes uniform)
